**SIX** When a team has only 6 players for a game, the coach must identify which portion of the game each player will sit out, based on the following schedule:

1<sup>st</sup> quarter      2<sup>nd</sup> quarter      3<sup>rd</sup> qtrter (1<sup>st</sup> half)      3<sup>rd</sup> qtrter (2<sup>nd</sup> half)      4<sup>th</sup> qtrter (1<sup>st</sup> half)      4<sup>th</sup> qtrter (2<sup>nd</sup> half)

**Players arriving after the opening tipoff may play in the second quarter. Refer to WBB RULE #13. The team will be assessed a technical foul to start the second period and the coach must revise his rotations. If a player leaves the game due to injury or fouling out, both coaches have one minute to confer and agree on a replacement of comparable skill level **OUT OF EARSHOT** of all players. If an agreement cannot be reached in that time, the Division Coordinator will choose the replacement for them. **VIOLATION OF THESE ROTATION RULES IS A TECHNICAL FOUL** which, if discovered, may be assessed at the discretion of the officials without warning. **Multiple violations of the rotation rules by a team in one game result in a game forfeit and three or more violations in one season by a coach will be reported to WBB League and lead to disciplinary action.****
